

Osthafenforum – how to get there

Lindleystraße 15 (just across from Lindleystraße 11), D-60314 Frankfurt am Main

Via public transport (for timetables visit www.rmv.de/c/en)

You can take the subway **U6** or a regional train until **Frankfurt Ostbahnhof** (exit Hanauer Landstraße/Honsellstraße), from there it's a ten to fifteen minute walk.

Or you may take **tram line 11** from the city in the direction Schießhüttenstraße (Fechenheim) and alight at station **Schwedlerstraße**. From there it's three to five minutes on foot: a few meters along Hanauer Landstraße in the direction of travel, then a turn to the right into Schwedlerstraße and then again to the right into Lindleystraße; number 15 is a new light-coloured building to the right, just across from Lindleystraße 11 (not between numbers 13 and 17).

Tram line 11 also passes Frankfurt main station, urban railway station Ostendstraße as well as the subway station Ostbahnhof (switch here to tram line 11 at tram station Ostbahnhof/Honsellstraße).

Bicycle parking area

You may use the bicycle parking area close to the building.

By car (navigation system)

Please note: The address Lindleystraße 15 is relatively new and therefore not yet included in all navigation systems. The building is not situated between number 13 and 17, but just across Lindleystraße 11 which may be found in navigation systems.

Usually, the parking lots close to the house are all occupied, so please plan with some time to look for a parking space.

The next public parking (subject to a fee) is „Union-Parkhaus“ in Lindleystraße 21.

Accessibility

All rooms in Lindleystraße 15 are wheelchair accessible. In the surroundings of the building, there are still some construction sites with barriers, though. Unfortunately, so far there are no accessible parking bays directly at the building, but it is possible to drive directly to the entrance to exit.
